




When the girls arrived at the science lab, Ava was there, as Audrey suspected. She was doing some of her scientific baking and making some of her really cute DIY's.

The girls all decided that Ava should be the team's designer because she knew everything about designing and because her dad was a coach for another robotics team. Ava also made really good cookies.


Now, the team was complete!












After Audrey finished the program,
