My name is Mary and I do robots.




In 2016 we formed
The Wollondilly Roobots




No, it is not a typo, we formed


We learnt heaps and had lots of fun. William and lucas drove the robot at tournaments and Scrimmage



We all built the robot




And I worked on the engineering book

It was great!!




We did everything possible



When we returned to Australia people kept forgetting that I was in the team. They talked to William and Lucas like they did everything and I just went along for fun.




Some of the Boys at My school even said


After searching for 1 day I found my friend Hannah. She was keen to give it a crack and learn about robots. Great.








NO WAY!!




Hannah and I tried everything and had a great time, but I just did not enjoy driving. We came last. We didn't make it to the finals.

We won the design award - yeah and the Roobots won the tournament. It started to dawn on me that Womdots needed another member.


So we went on the hunt and found

she could drive!!




So between the three of us we wrote up our design changes in the engineering book, changed our robot design, programmed our robot for skills challenge and all tried driving although I was still the worst at that.



The Roobots and high school teams discovered they weren't so good at writing down all their design changes, so I helped them plan and fill in their engineering book.



At the Nationals it rained lots which meant not all teams could make it.


We still could not drive very well and one of the High School teams we helped won the excellence Award.
