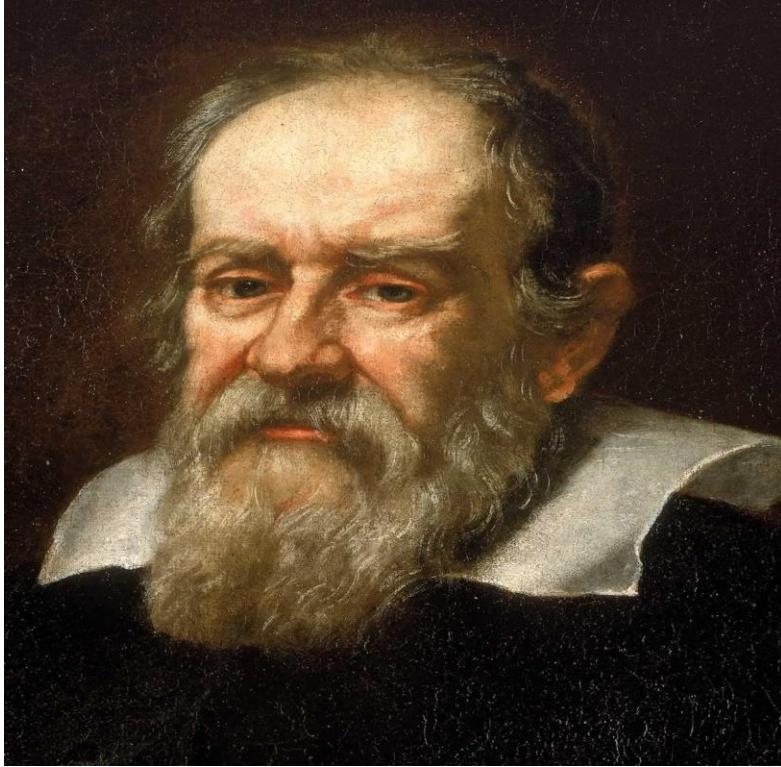


Hi! My name is Willow, and I'll answer a few questions I was asked by Ms. Rodgers.

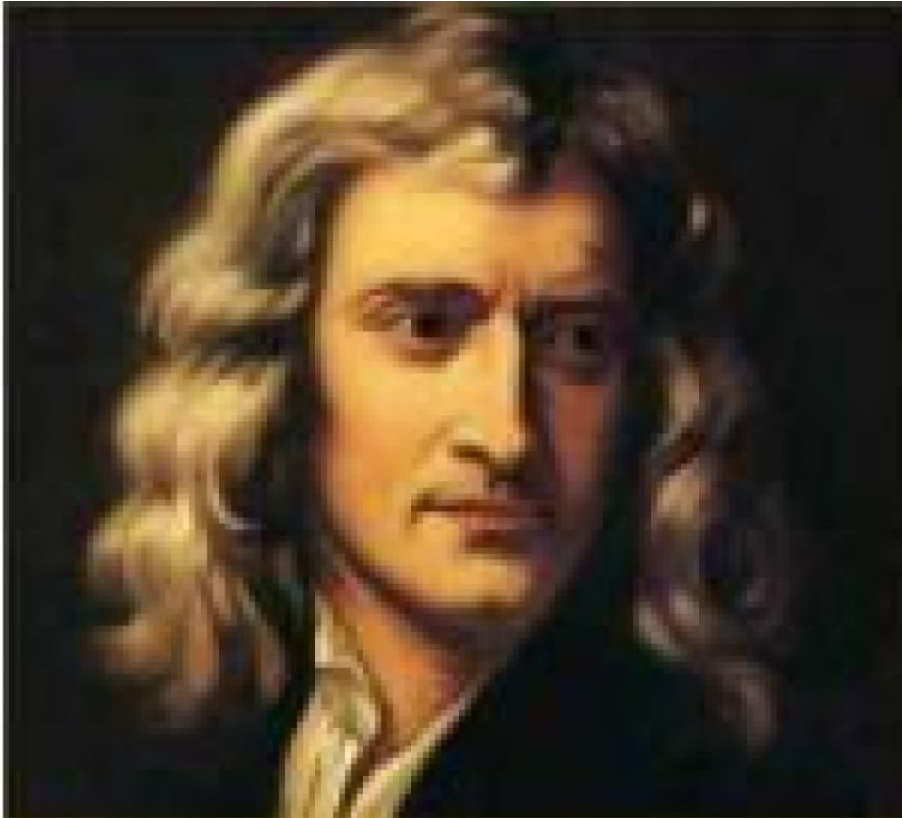
