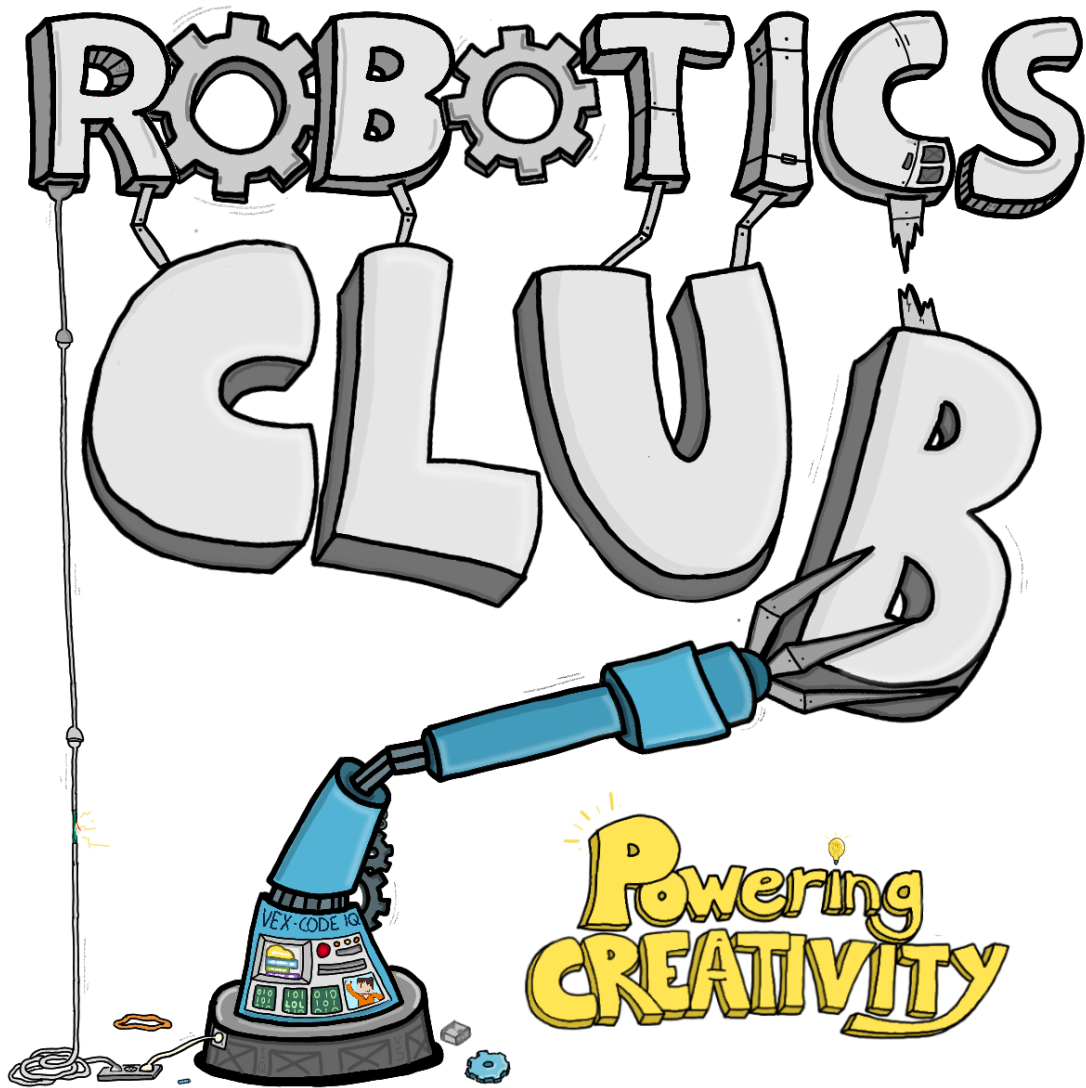


# **Poster Design Submission**
