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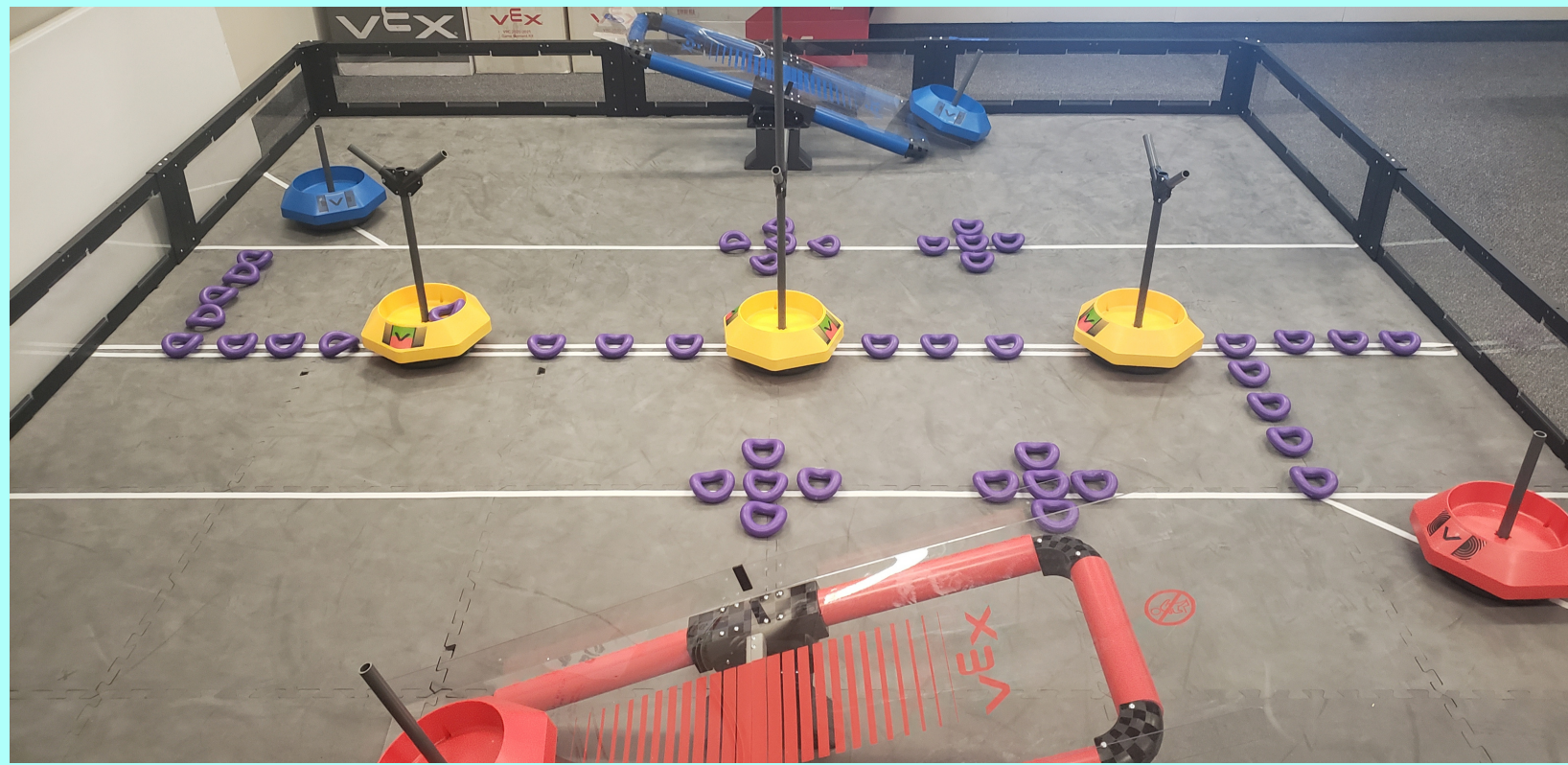

VEX VRC - Tipping Point 2021/2022

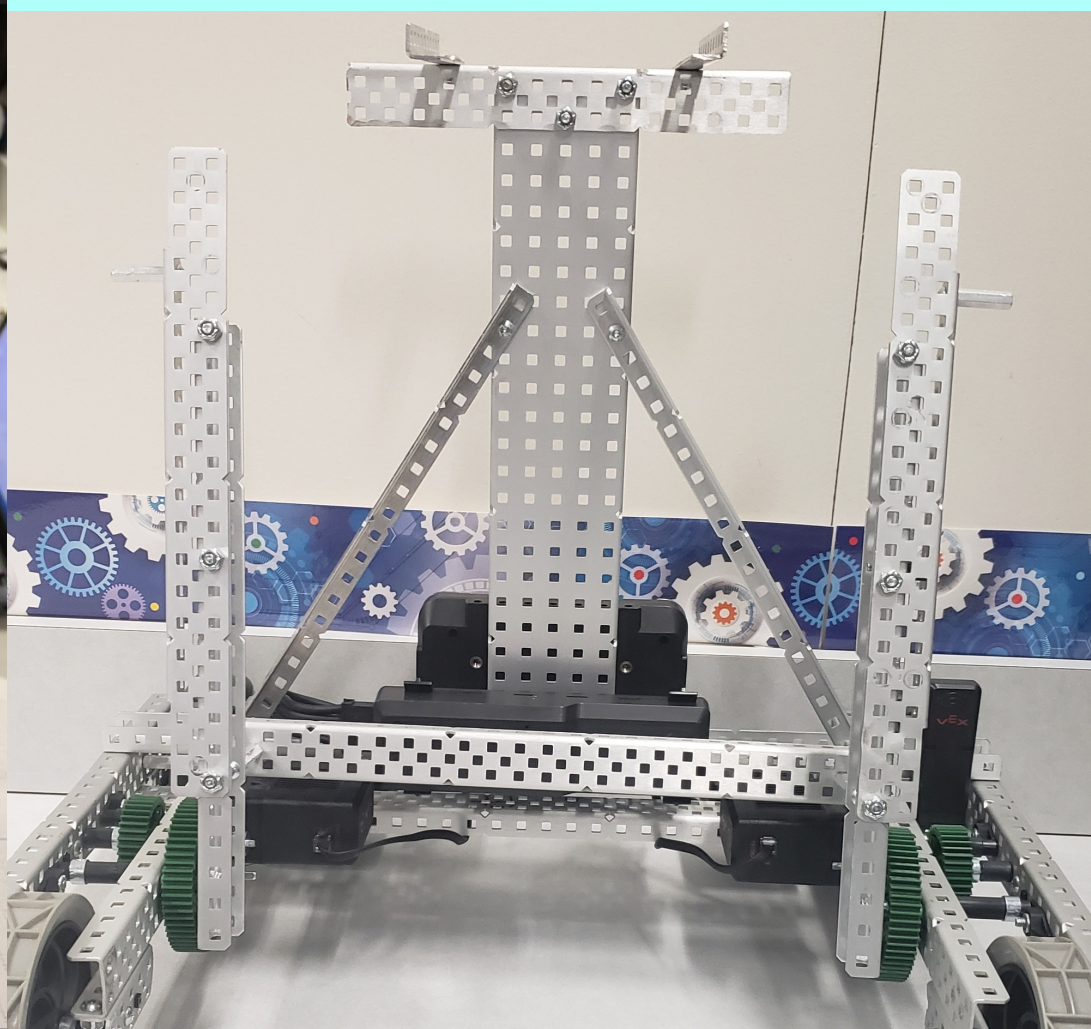
