We were a all girl team of mostly freshman



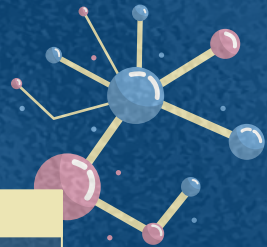

This was the year the team was made it was a all girls team back then



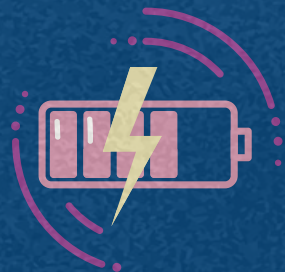
## About our coach
