Counting, although a simple mathematical concept, is an inalienable component of VEX Robotics. After a match, teams are responsible for keeping track of the score to find inconsistencies with the ruling. The image depicts the aftermath of a match, where members from two opposing teams meet to discuss the points. The standing dinosaur is declaring that there are two rings scored in the opposing alliance goal, and he has two fingers to defend his argument. The other dinosaur believes there are 10 rings scored, but doesn't quite have enough fingers to prove it, so the judges align with the former.
