It focuses on expressing this message through pictures rather than words, and leads viewers to the VEX website should they want more information.

When we designed this poster, our goal was to highlight our favorite parts of VEX with as little words as possible; we wanted to show, not tell. When brainstorming, multiple members from our team drew a design, and then we combined our favorite aspects of each to get a general idea of what we wanted to make. When deciding what words and phrases to use on our poster, we first created a list of words related to the tasks we did in our most recent iteration of the robot. After doing so, we sorted them and chose the most powerful and encompassing words to express the valuable skills that our team has gained from competing in this season alone.
