


Inclusivity

Marie Curie was a famous scientist. She was born in Poland in 1867. In 1891 she moved to Paris, France to study math and physics, and she was the best student in her class. Later on, she taught classes in Paris and did science experiments. Curie found that only certain elements give off rays of energy. She called this radioactivity. In 1898, Marie, and her husband Pierre discovered 2 new elements. They named them polonium and radium. In 1903, they won the Nobel Prize in physics for their work with radium. In 1911 she won the Nobel Prize in chemistry. She was the first person in history to win 2 Nobel Prizes! She is our role model because she showed the world that women could do anything and everything they put their mind to do (and more!).
