


Field Transformed

As tension rises between the Red and Blue alliance, the alliances gathers intel. At the frontmost of this is the walled city of Berlin, Berlin, the capital city of Germany, played a significant role during the Cold War, which lasted from the end of World War II in 1945 until the collapse of the Soviet Union in 1991. The city was divided into East and West, with the East controlled by the Red Team and the West controlled by the Blue Team.

The city was located deep within East Germany and was surrounded by the Soviet-controlled East German state. As a result, the city became a major point of contention between the two sides.

The East German government, with the support of the Red team, erected the Berlin Wall in to prevent people leaving the city.


Because of all this tension, Red and Blue spies are hard at work gather intel to gain an advantage in a potential conflict. The two sides coincidentally came up with 2 identical plans, both called—**Operation Spin Up.**



The spies plan to gather intel stored in flat yellow disks and transport them out of the city by mid-air retrieval systems, or Skyhook. The Fulton surface-to-air recovery system (STARS) is a system used by the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA), United States Air Force and United States Navy for retrieving objects on the ground using aircraft such as the MC-130E and Boeing B-17. It involves using an harness and a self-inflating balloon with an attached lift line. An Plane engages the line with its V-shaped yoke and the object is reeled on board. If retrieval is successful, the spies will earn 5 intel points. If the retrieval fails the opposing spies will earn 1 intel point if it isn't recovered before time runs out.



On the border of Berlin, there are 4 passcode rollers, the rollers have numbers on them, if the roller's number is correct(shows only one color), the code is decrypted, that alliance now owns the roller and gains 10 intel points.



When there are only 10 seconds left, the spies are allowed to plant listening devices. These listening devices can be very small, but they can cover entire city blocks. With everyone wiretapped, each city block that the spy covers gains them 3 intel points.
