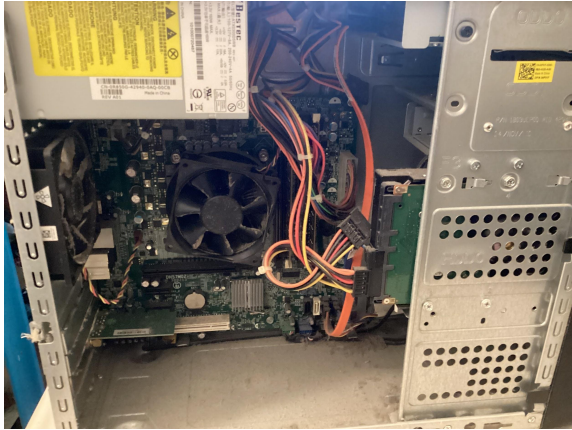

First part off!!!



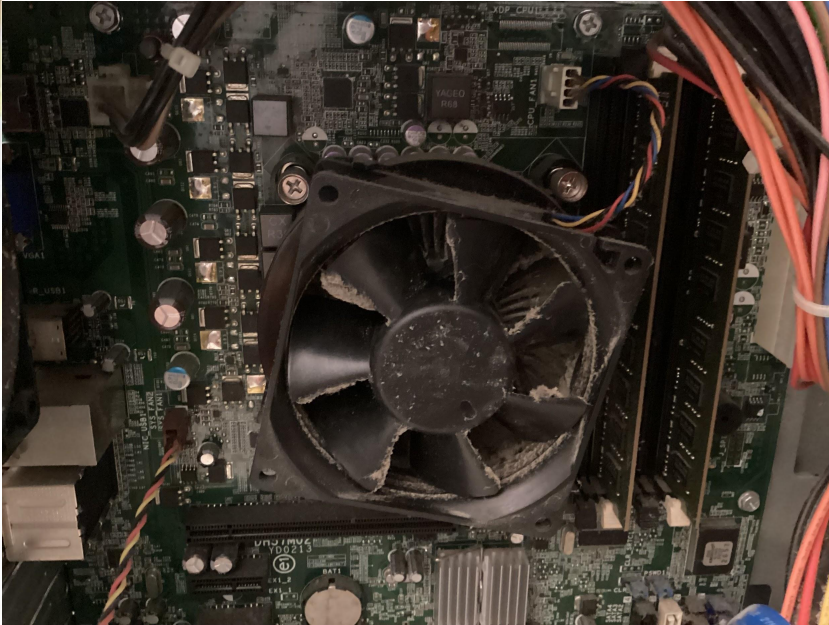

I took the memory out



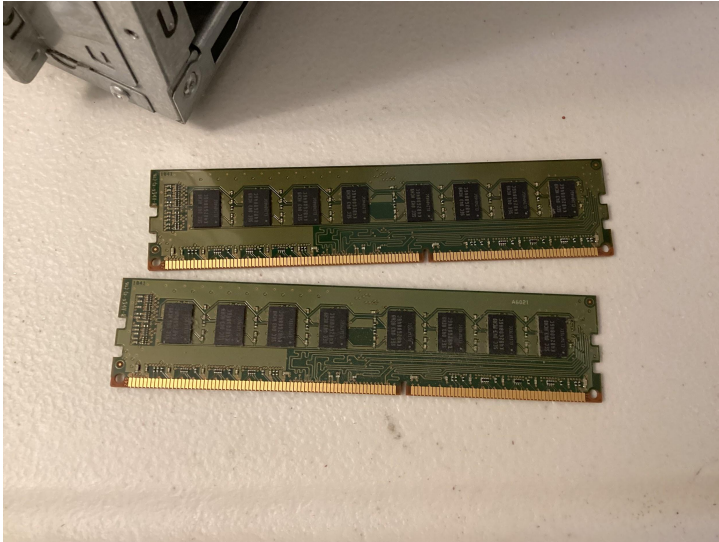
